COME VISIT US

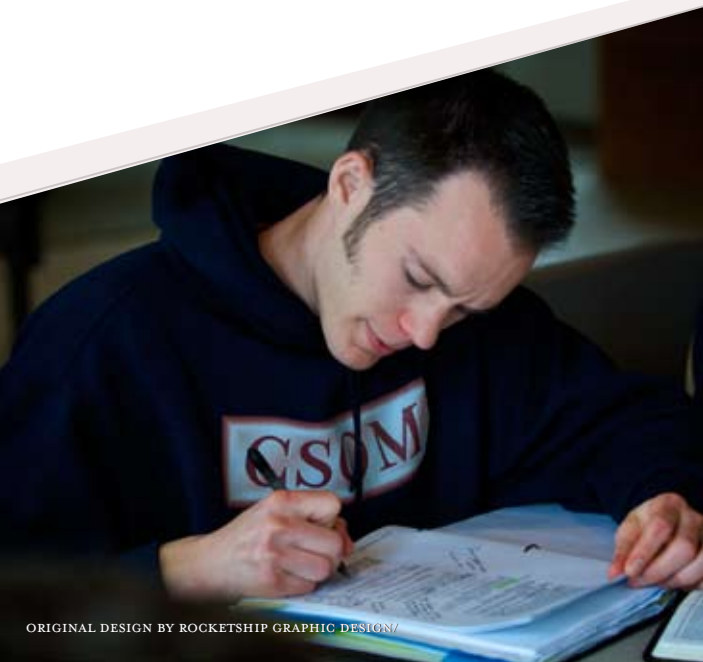

VISION STATEMENT

Our goal at Cornerstone School of Ministry (CSOM) is the same as the Apostle Paul had for the Christians at Philippi (Philippians 1:9-11):

We are committed to teaching the Bible in such a way that (1) students are equipped to properly handle the Word of God; (2) they are encouraged to think critically of what they believe and why they believe as they reason through the breadth and depth of theology; (3) they will learn to become ministers (those who serve), and to do so humbly for the body of Christ and (4) they will give consideration to, and hopefully come to the knowledge of the purpose that God has for their lives. Our foremost desire is that these goals are realized in an environment that fosters a love abounding more and more in all things.

- Get to work in fellowship with other believers on challenging tasks.
- Become well equipped in studying the Word of God.
- Become critically equipped with the diverse theological and interpretational views held by the breadth of Christianity.
- Read through the whole Bible while thoroughly studying it.
- Work on time management.
- Develop valuable ministry skills.
- Have a chance to take a guided trip to Israel or Mission Outreach to another country.
- Create lasting friendships with classmates!



CORNERSTONE LIFE

We encourage students at Cornerstone to be involved in the body of Christ in many different ways. We have daily prayer and worship and weekly pastoral discipleship. We also encourage weekly church attendance at an evangelical fellowship in the Corvallis community.

We have students actively involved in spiritual and practical ministries in and around the Cornerstone classrooms. Cornerstone also has a house-group program designed to help students quickly become academically and socially networked. See the catalog for full descriptions in each of these areas.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: I cannot afford the tuition. Does CSOM offer scholarships?

A: Yes. We have a limited scholarship program (maximum of \$1,000/person/year) based mostly on financial need. For a form, click to the financial information page on the website.

Q: Can I attend college (OSU/LBCC) at the same time as CSOM?

A: Yes, but we do not recommend enrolling in a full-time CSOM program if you are concurrently attending another institution.

Q: How many hours do you recommend I work while attending CSOM?

A: A few of the students hold full-time jobs. For them, CSOM presents challenges in time management, diligence and hard work. While the workload at CSOM is college-level, it is not insurmountable. A 15 to 20 hour work week is ideal.
